PUBLIC WALKING TOURS: Saturdays, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., May 23 through September 26. Open to all visitors. Admission fee required. Museum members free. Volunteers needed to guide visitors, staff the museum store and conduct trolley operations.

TROLLEY RIDES: Second and fourth Saturday of the month, May 23 through September 26, weather permitting. 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Departures on the hour and half hour. Last run departs at 3:30pm. Trolley ride tickets required. Fares for adults and children posted on line and at the Museum. Museum members ride free. Additional times and dates may be added as conditions warrant. 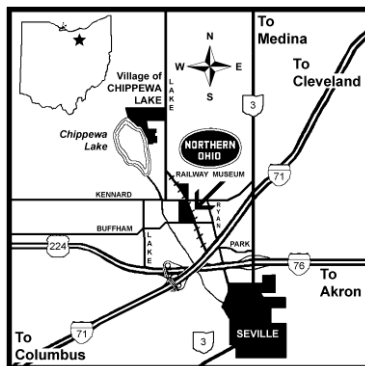

The Museum is located at 5515 Buffham Road in Westfield Township, Medina County, Ohio, near Chippewa Lake and Seville. From the I-71/I-76/224 interchange, take 224 west 4/10 of a mile to County Road 19 (Lake Road). Turn right (north) on Lake and go 6/10 of a mile to Buffham Road. Turn right (east) on Buffham and go 1 mile. The museum will then be on your left.
