### **Northern Ohio Railway Museum Opens for Season on May 23<sup>rd</sup>**

Seville, Ohio—Northern Ohio Railway Museum, 5515 Buffham Road, will open for the season on May 23<sup>rd</sup>. The museum will be open every Saturday from 10 am to 4 pm until September 26<sup>th</sup>. We invite you to tour the museum's collection and ride our vintage trolley and rapid transit cars.

The museum offers walking tours of its collection of over forty streetcars, interurbans and rapid transit cars. The cars on display date from 1895 to 1970. Learn about the mode of transportation that helped to define and build northern Ohio. Walking tours will take you through our buildings and grounds. Tours typically take about thirty minutes and happen at your own pace.

Also available for viewing, on an hourly basis, is the 46-minute film THE TROLLEY. Originally produced for IMAX screens, it is shown here in large screen HD video. We are the only place you can see this film in Ohio. It is a cinematic experience not to be missed.

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays of the month, we also offer rides on our vintage cars, in addition to the walking tours and the film. Available to ride is Car 12, a 1914 product of Cleveland's G.C. Kuhlman Car Company. This car had a long career starting on the city streets of Cleveland and finishing on the lines of the Shaker Heights Rapid Transit. Also available is Car 109, a 1954 rapid transit car built for the Cleveland Transit System. Car 109 is also ADA accessible. Rides take about 20 minutes.

On operating days, admission is \$7.00 for adults, 13 and older. Children 6 to 12 are \$3.00. Those under 6 ride free. Museum members are free. Admission includes tours, the film and unlimited rides. Cars will operate half-hourly, 11:00 - 3:30. On non-operating days, admission is a flat \$3.00, 6 and older. Those under 6 are free. Tours and the film are available.

Northern Ohio Railway Museum is a not-for-profit, Ohio corporation as described by section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Its goals are to collect, preserve, restore, display and operate streetcars and other electric railway equipment for the education and enjoyment of the public. The Museum is located on over sixty acres of land at 5515 Buffham Road in Seville, Medina County, Ohio, near Chippewa Lake. At this site the Museum has built track and three large buildings to house its collection of historic streetcars, interurbans, and rapid transit cars, most from the northern Ohio area. Membership is open to anyone who is interested. Volunteers are also sought to help operate the Museum.
